<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> The Troop will enforce financial obligations that are associated with a Scout's commitment to participate in an activity or event, even if the Scout is unable to participate (for any reason). If the Troop spends funds for a Scout to participate, the fee will be assessed unless another Scout replaces the first Scout.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Be aware that beginning this year the Troop will pay a \$36 "Program Fee" per Scout, to Knox Trail Council, but in return does NOT receive any funding from the Council. The program fee will cover certain camp expenses and adult leader training costs.
